Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA), Enhancing HIV Care of Women, Infants, Children and Youth, Building Capacity Through Communities of Practice (CoP) Project

Bizzell supports the Division of Community HIV/AIDS Programs (DCHAP) by providing foundational, targeted and intensive technical assistance services, including three yearlong programs through CoP for Ryan White Part D recipients. The CoP focus on preconception counseling that includes behavioral health, sexual health, trauma-informed care and youth transitioning into adult Ryan White HIV/AIDS programs. We manage three virtual CoP, conduct needs assessments of the CoP participants, develop and share resource materials to enhance workflows and services to the populations served, conduct interactive learning sessions, guide participants through quality improvement projects and provide leadership sessions with each recipient to ensure the enhancement of services to women, infants, children and youth enrolled in Ryan White Part D programs.

HRSA, Maternal Child Health Bureau (MCHB), Sickle Cell Disease (SCD) Newborn Screening Follow-up Program (NSFP) Technical Assistance (TA) Project

Bizzell collaborates with the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) Maternal and Child Health Bureau (MCHB) to enhance health outcomes for individuals living with sickle cell disease (SCD). This partnership focuses on developing statewide and regional networks of SCD support services and utilizing the specialized knowledge of community-based organizations and community health workers. By providing financial and organizational technical assistance, we aim to improve grant administration and program monitoring. Our efforts are directed towards enhancing the capabilities of grantees, enabling them to effectively implement crucial programs and services that support families affected by SCD. Through these comprehensive measures, Bizzell plays a pivotal role in fostering a robust support system for the SCD community.

Innovating Child Care Solutions: Bizzell's Strategic Support to the Office of Child Care (OCC)

Bizzell's work with the OCC under the Administration for Children and Families (ACF) showcases our innovative solutions amid budget constraints and the critical need for quality Early Care and Education (ECE) for low-income children. Using the Child Care Communications Management Center (CMC), we enhanced the dissemination of key policies and information to childcare stakeholders, providing comprehensive technical assistance (TA) and communications support to facilitate affordable and quality child care across Native American tribal institutions, states, and territories. Through the CMC, we mobilized logistical, communication, and technical services for conferences, roundtables, and webinars, including developing training materials, direct vendor billing, event planning, and streamlining operations for effective stakeholder engagement. Adopting web-based technologies for meetings and training sessions enabled broader participation despite geographical and budgetary constraints. Our success with the OCC underscores our commitment to impactful ECE programs, navigating challenges, and reinforcing the foundation for accessible, high-quality child care services.

Enhancing Maternal and Child Health Bureau (MCHB): Bizzell's Innovative Solutions for HRSA's Research to Practice Initiatives

Bizzell's collaboration with HRSA through the Coordinating Center for Research to Practice Partnerships (CC-R2PP) initiative demonstrates our innovative approach to linking research with real-world applications within the MCHB. We focused on strengthening connections between academic research and public health implementation through Research Networks (RN) and Special Interest Interdisciplinary Projects (SIIPs) to enhance maternal and child health outcomes. By facilitating collaboration, promoting research dissemination, and enhancing the capacities of RN/SIIPs alongside MCHB divisions, we conducted comprehensive needs assessments, identified opportunities for cooperation, and managed a Virtual Learning Collaborative (VLC) for shared learning among stakeholders. A key highlight is the development and management of a Moodle-based Virtual Learning Platform, serving as a hub for cooperative learning and research dissemination, significantly aiding in translating research into impactful public health practices. Our comprehensive dissemination plan underscores our commitment to improving health outcomes for maternal and child populations by enhancing research-practice connections through strategic services and innovative solutions.
